## How do I create an Avoiding Plagiarism Quiz link in UTSOnline?

Instructors and Subject Coordinators can create a link in their UTSOnline subject site to an Avoiding Plagiarism quiz. By creating this link in UTSOnline, you can take advantage of a student's Avoiding Plagiarism quiz results being automatically pushed to the UTSOnline subject site Grade Centre.

**Step 1 of 6:** Log into UTSOnline and access your UTSOnline subject site from the **My Subjects** module.
